Southampton & District Beekeepers Association 2011-2012 Subscription Details

Membership Subscriptions are due annually on **1st October**. Subscriptions of **new** members joining on or after July 1st shall also cover the next year following however this **excludes BDI and Capitation** payments.

The standard subscription for a registered member is made up of four parts, comprising: S&DBKA Subscription £15.50 + Capitation BBKA and HBA £20.00 + Minimum BDI premium £2.00 Total = £37.50

Classes of membership

Registered Member Individual keeping bees.

Partner Member Adult individual keeping bees residing at the same address as a registered member.

Country Member Individual not keeping bees.

Junior Member..... Individuals 18 years of age or under on 30 September 2011, who keep more than two hives under the guidance of a registered or partner member.

Friend Individuals not keeping bees unless insured for BDI via another association or BDI scheme B, shall be entitled to attend and participate in all meetings of SDBKA.

Member's Friend..... Criteria as for a Friend but residing at registered member's or partner member's address.

It is a condition of membership that members or friends with bees must be insured with Bee Diseases Insurance via S&DBKA, another association or BDI scheme B.

The insurance premium for the first three colonies is included in the membership fee for Registered, Partner & Junior Members. The premium for additional colonies is calculated thus:-

Members with 40 or more colonies can only insure with scheme B by application to B D I Ltd. Compensation will only be paid IN PROPORTION to the number of colonies premiums paid for and not the total number owned at the time foul brood is discovered. So please pay full premium for full cover. *Note all hives containing bees regardless of size must be insured for cover to be effective. Premiums paid after 31st March 2012 entail a wait of 60 days for cover.

BEE CRAFT Orders for BEE CRAFT magazine must be received before 1st November 2011. The discount rate through the association is £21.60 including postage for 12 copies, Jan - Dec 2012.

BEEKEEPERS QUARTERLY Four issues at an association bulk discount rate of £18.00 per subscriber including postage, (normal individual rate £28.00) orders must be received before 1st November 2011.

Spray Liaison Scheme

Members are encouraged to register with Beebase on the National Bee Unit website (www.nationalbeeunit.com) a wide range of free information is available and beekeepers will be notified of any new disease outbreak within 5km of their apiaries.
